Local Rules January 1, 2019

Windsor Men's Golf Club tournament play is governed by the current edition of the USGA Rules of Golf.

Silos on the Hole 3

In this competition the silos on 3rd hole are deemed to be integral parts of the golf course.

Out of Bounds behind Hole 3 green

The area behind the 3rd hole, defined by white stakes and the inner edge of the cart path, is out of bounds.

Inside the course Out of Bounds while playing the 17th Hole

While playing the 17th hole, a ball that crosses the white stakes located to the left of the 17th hole teeing area and comes to rest on the 2nd hole side of the white stakes is out of bounds.

Dropping Zones (Ball Drops)

In this competition a player shall not use the dropping zones located on holes 5 and 13.

Pace of Play

The Windsor Men's Golf Club's Pace of Play policy is in effect for this competition.

Aeration Holes

Ball Deflected by Power Line (new)

"If it is *known or virtually certain* that a player's ball hit a power line [or tower or a wire or pole supporting a power line] during the play of holes 1, 9 and 18, the stroke does not count. The player must play a ball without penalty from where the previous stroke was made (see [Rule 14.6](#) for what to do).

Penalty for Playing Ball from a Wrong Place in Breach of Local Rule: General Penalty Under Rule 14.7a.
